



# Dental Treatment Guarantee

At Anzac Avenue Dental, we believe that the quality of the dental treatment we provide is of the highest standard. We are pleased to support this belief with a limited warranty that will cover some specific parts of your dental treatment.

Regular maintenance of your teeth and gums is vital to ensure the success of your new restorations, so we encourage you to attend your 6 monthly preventive care appointments. Regular maintenance includes a restorative and periodontal exam every six months, a professional clean and polish every six months, and routine radiographs every twelve months.

Based on current research, we expect that your ceramic restoration should last in excess of 10-12 years if it is properly cared for. Composite restorations have a life span of 3-4 years after which time they will begin to discolour and leak. While the restoration may remain in place, it is advisable to have it replaced to minimise the risk of re-current decay. These estimates are conservative and with proper care, your restoration may last longer than this.

If your new crown, bridge, ceramic restoration or veneer cracks, chips or breaks during the next three years, we will replace it free of charge, providing you have attended your regular 6 monthly preventive care appointments since the completion of your treatment, and providing you complete all the recommended treatment, including any protective splints or night guards we recommended. Composite resin restorations will be replaced free of charge during the next 12 months, under the same conditions.

Implant fixtures have a warranty of 20 years, again providing regular 6 monthly preventive care appointments are maintained here at Anzac Avenue Dental.

This limited warranty applies to fabrication and normal wear and tear only and will not apply if your teeth are damaged through any type of accident or injury. Failure to maintain your dental treatment by not attending six monthly preventive care appointments, or not completing the recommended treatment will also void this warranty. Restorations placed in or on teeth with a questionable long term prognosis or suspected nerve damage will not be guaranteed. Chipping or fracture due to non-compliance in wearing your protective splint or night guard will also void this warranty.
